Nigeria:

- Visa:
 - Recommend using a Visa service like Travel Visa Pro https://www.travelvisapro.com/visa/nigeria.
 Necessary information is on the site.
 - A discount for the service fee is possible by entering Wycliffe in the discount field when asked.
 - Apply for single entry Business.
 - A Letter of Invitation will be required. This document will provide the information for your local contact in Nigeria.
 - We will contact you for information so we can obtain a Letter of Invitation that you will add to the application.
 - Travel with at least one 2x2 passport photo and photo copy of passport.
 - O Suggest a lead time of 4-6 weeks to obtain Letter of Invitation and secure visa.
- Medical:
 - There are a number of shots that are recommended and required to travel to Nigeria.
 - Yellow Fever
 - Tetanus
 - Suggest Typhoid
 - Malarial meds
 - o You are encouraged to visit www.cdc.gov for the most up to date travel info.
- Clothes:
 - o For Men:
 - Trousers and collared shirt during the day. Tee shirts are ok off hours and shorts while in the Guest House.
 - o For Women:
 - Long dresses and covered shoulders. Trousers in the Guest House and possibly at other off hour times.
 - o Shoes or sandals are acceptable for men and women
- Make sure to check the local weather before you travel! Anywhere in the world can be chilly!
- Things to bring:
 - Refillable water purification bottle
 - We recommend this one: http://shop.camelbak.com/all-clear-bottle/d/1208
 - Bug Spray
 - Snacks (protein bars, trail mix, candy bars, etc.)
 - o Sun Screen
- Have a copy of your itinerary of your return flight (with your name on it) and a copy of your travel insurance paperwork easily accessible (especially when traveling).
- Other helpful tips:
 - Please do not book tickets without checking itinerary with Team Lead. Travel requires arrival and departure from Abuja (ABV) airport. Travel will be arranged between airport and workshop site in Jos which is about 5 hours. If arrival is late afternoon then overnight guesthouse accommodations will be made and travel up the next day.
 - Team Lead will determine best days/times for arrival to minimize travel costs between airport and workshop site.
 - If the workshop is in Jos you will most likely stay at the WA guesthouse which has good accommodations.
 Towels and linens are provided and there is usually hot water and all plumbing is indoors.
